

- BI Incorporated (BI) was founded in 1978, in Boulder, Colo., where the company maintains its home office today at 6400 Lookout Road.
- BI entered the community corrections market in 1985 and pioneered electronic monitoring of offenders being supervised in the community, typically as they participate in “house arrest” programs.
- BI has more than 700 employees nationwide today.
- The accurate company name is BI Incorporated. The “BI” in BI Incorporated is not an abbreviation. Behavioral Interventions is used only as a tagline.
- BI is a national leader for intensive supervision technologies, community-based treatment services, and reentry and cognitive behavioral programs for adult and juvenile offenders released on parole, probation or pretrial release.
- To achieve success, BI assesses the risks and needs of individuals we supervise, matches services to address those risks and needs, and holds individuals accountable for their behavior. BI works closely with public officials to reduce recidivism, promote public safety and strengthen the communities we serve.
- BI offers the largest portfolio of products and services for community corrections agencies in the United States today. BI offers:
 - More than a dozen compliance technologies that help monitor individuals released to community supervision
 - Sophisticated call center monitoring services and technical support
 - Cognitive behavioral programs for juvenile and adult parolees and probationers
 - Community-based electronic monitoring offices and offender-pay programs
 - Web-based software applications that allow direct client data access and management
- The company’s manufacturing and research and development functions for electronic monitoring products are located in Boulder, Colo.
- BI’s 24x7x365 national monitoring center, called the BI GuardCenter, is located in Anderson, Ind. The GuardCenter monitors approximately 32,000 offenders daily.
- BI is ISO 9001:2008-certified for all aspects of electronic monitoring including design, manufacturing, installation, support, and monitoring services.
- In the United States, BI’s customers include federal, state and local correctional agencies. Today, BI has approximately 900 contracts for its products and services.
- BI has successfully operated the Intensive Supervision Appearance Program (ISAP) for the Department of Homeland Security since 2004. ISAP is a growing and successful alternative to detention for program participants as they attend immigration hearings and live in the community.
- Internationally, BI supports correctional agencies in Canada, Puerto Rico, and Guam.
- BI maintains more than 40 offices that provide offender treatment and supervision services in local communities.
- Bruce Thacher became BI’s third CEO and President in 2008.
- BI holds 30 patents worldwide; 16 of which are in the United States.

- BI GuardCenter monitors more than 32,000 offenders daily via GPS tracking, radio frequency, voice, or remote alcohol detection systems.
- In total, BI technology and services are currently used to monitor approximately 60,000 individuals daily.
- GuardCenter monitoring specialists handle approximately 100,000 calls each month.
- BI has monitored more than 4 million offenders since it began offering electronic monitoring systems to government agencies in 1985.
- Inbound calls are answered within an average of 4.5 seconds.
